Annual Meeting and Conference June 13-15



Want to be Board?

No, we are not talking about a state of boredom., but we are seeking candidates to fill three positions on the Florida Chapter Board of Directors.

The Board is responsible for planning educational and other events for the chapter. Nine members work together to bring about everything that the Chapter does. There is no compensation but it is a rewarding position as you are helping Florida tax preparers to stay current on the tax laws and network with fellow preparers. There are nine Board members who serve three-year terms. The Board holds several meetings each year, either in person or via Zoom.

Chapter members who are at least 18 years of age and in good standing are eligible to be nominated as Director candidates. The period for recommendation to the Nomination Committee shall close 45 days before the election. Members may nominate themselves. If you wish to be considered you must submit an application which is included on the following page.

If you don't think you are ready for Board membership, you can volunteer to serve on a committee. Committee membership is by appointment by the Board. If you are interested in serving in this capacity contact the President or any Board member for more information. Member participation is vital to maintaining an ongoing quality state chapter.

The John and Bibi Rudestedt Chapter Growth Scholarship Fund FAQS

What is the purpose? This scholarship fund is to help tax professionals in the State of Florida obtain continuing education through the Florida NATP Chapter, and to help introduce tax professionals to our Chapter.

What is involved in the scholarship? The scholarship will cover the cost of registration to one FL NATP Conference. In order to be considered, you must complete an application and send it to us by the application deadline. Depending on the availability of funds, there may be more than one scholarship offered each year. Note that the scholarship covers only the registration fee. The winner is responsible for travel, meals, lodging and other incidentals.

How can we afford to do this? To fund the scholarships we hold fundraisers and take donations. We do hold a raffle at each conference with items donated by various members or companies. The proceeds are placed in the scholarship fund.

Who are John and Bibi Rudestedt? Both John and Bibi have been very active within our chapter as well as nationally in NATP. They have dedicated much time and effort toward the growth of the Florida Chapter. Education is an important aspect of the tax profession so we want to enable tax professionals to have access to outstanding education. They have worked hard to provide this education and we are honoring and continuing their efforts through this scholarship.
